- Community Schools planning grant submitted on behalf of Enos Garcia.

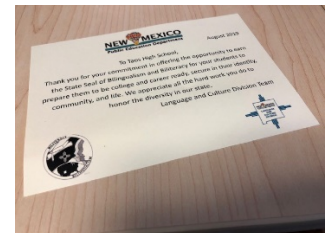
